DMV Registration **CONDITIONAL** Acceptance Letter 2024

This is an invitation to bring your Mutant Vehicle to Burning Man 2024 for on-playa inspection; however your invitation is **CONDITIONAL** upon certain requirements being met.

During the review of your vehicle, the DMV Review Team felt there were some issues you needed to address before bringing your vehicle to the playa:

CONDITIONAL - LEVEL OF EXECUTION - MOOP

The DMV Review team had some concerns as to how well your vehicle would execute against the design images provided. Your vehicle needs to match, as reasonably close as possible, the design images you provided in your application.

In consideration of the significant amount of work referenced elsewhere in the application, you will be conditionally invited subject to the fulfillment of the described mutation. Unless your vehicle's mutation has been well-executed, it will not be granted a license.

The review team also has concerns with possible moop (Matter out of place) that might be created by some components of your vehicle noted in your application. We have had a number of issues in the past with vehicles that 'shedded' components of their vehicles (Fur, grass skirts, palm fronds, bamboo,

cardboard and any number of types of decorations) under playa conditions.

Remember that winds on the playa can gust over 50 mph, and you will want to plan and build accordingly.

We will want to see a clear indication that you have addressed any moop concerns when you bring your vehicle to its on-playa inspection.

***** YOU MUST STILL BRING YOUR VEHICLE TO THE ON-PLAYA DMV FOR FINAL INSPECTION/LICENSING *****

Actual licenses are granted in Black Rock City if and when you pass the on-playa inspection.

that your Mutant Vehicle project has passed the first level of review. PLEASE READ this entire letter for important information about next steps in bringing your vehicle to the playa.

ENTERING BRC:

You MUST bring a printout of this letter with you to Black Rock City. Gate personnel will not allow any towed vehicle into the event site without a copy of this letter. If you do not have this letter when you get to the Gate, you will have to leave the vehicle in the lot at the gate before entering the city. In this case, come to the DMV between Noon and 5pm and ask for help getting your vehicle into the event. Because those that brought their letter get serviced first, and because it is a taxing endeavor to get a towed vehicle through the gate without this letter, it may take hours or even days to get your vehicle in. Please remember this and be patient if you find yourself in this position.

GETTING TO THE DMV/LOCATION/HOURS

This letter allows you to drive your Mutant Vehicle from your camp to the DMV.

You will need to bring this letter, as well as your Government-Issued ID with name matching the primary name on your MV Application with you to the DMV. This letter needs to be in your vehicle (and readily accessible) during this short trip directly to the DMV. If you are stopped by Law Enforcement, the Black Rock Rangers, or any other authority, this letter shows you are in compliance with the rules of BRC. This only applies for the trip directly to the DMV from your camp.

The DMV is located on the Esplanade near

the Center

Camp. Check your BRC map for our specific location this year.

The DMV will announce the DMV operating hours via our DMV SparkPlug eMail Newsletter as we get nearer to the event. The SparkPlug is required reading for all Mutant Vehicle owners so please read each one carefully.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are applying for a night license, whether you are getting!

a day li

cence or not, you will need to make TWO trips to the DMV: a first trip during the day (before 6:30) for initial

inspections and to complete paperwork, and then again after dusk to have your lighting inspected and to receive your night license.

LICENSE LOCATION/SIZE NEEDED

At the DMV your vehicle will be photographed and inspected. If your vehicle passes inspection, it will be issued a license. Licenses are a 12" long by 3" high bumper sticker. Licenses must be affixed to the back of your vehicle on the lower-left (driver's) side; you should make allowances for this on your vehicle. If your vehicle is approved for a day and night license, you will need a 12" by 6" space for two stickers. The placement on the rear left side is MANDATORY. This applies to each trailer segment as well.

REGULATIONS/ENFORCEMENT

When you submitted your DMV application, you agreed to adhere to Black Rock City driving protocols.
